



One Page Website - Terms and Conditions

Definition

A one-page website is just that – one page. The menu structure uses page anchors to link visitors to various sections of the page. A one-pager is typically a long-scrolling layout.

Design

One Page Wonder uses theme designs, which is how website costs can be more affordable. The theme designs are customised with brand colours, fonts, imagery, video, and integrations to make them unique.

Delivery times

Due to the theme designs, One Page Wonder websites can be delivered faster than usual.

Below are time estimates for each package. Delivery is dependent upon when all assets are provided by the client e.g.: copy, images, and video:

- **Compact Comet:** 2 weeks
- **Supernova:** 3 weeks
- **Big Bang:** 4 weeks

Domain name

A new domain name is included in the One Page Wonder packages. If you already have a domain, we can use it and retain the registrar or migrate the domain to match the hosting. Domain names generally require renewal every 2 years. The client owns the domain name.

Hosting

One Page Wonder websites includes 12 month's hosting. Hosting is an annual cost.

Project terms and conditions

Clients agreeing to a One Page Wonder website project, they will also be bound by the Project Terms and Conditions. These terms and conditions are sent when a proposal for a one-page website project is agreed and signed.
